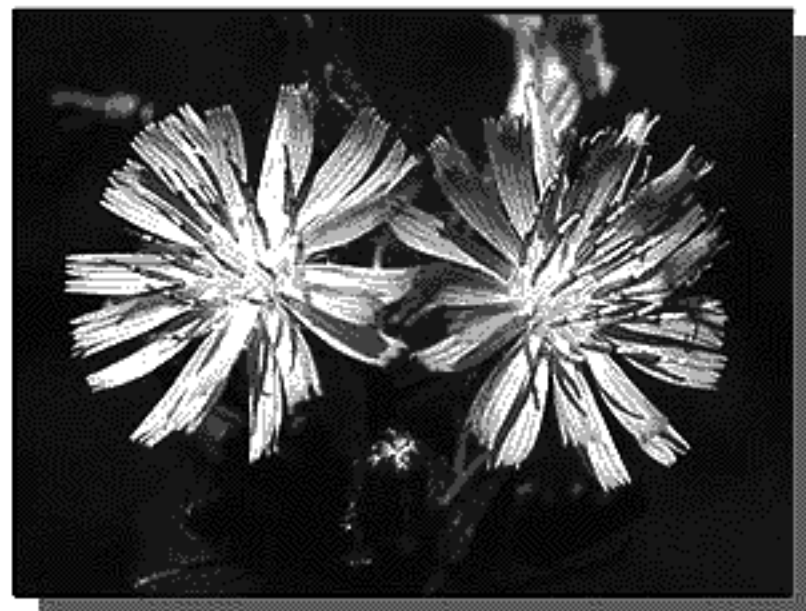


Science; Religion; Art—
