

On the difference between living Intelligence and mechanical Intellect

The movements of intelligence in Nature resonate together like the circular waves of water droplets merging on the surface of quiet water.

Shake one, and they all shake. Leave one out, and another steps in to take its place.

In contrast, the movements of mechanical intellect, like those of a computer, are based not so much on the *all-at-once* of the resonance of natural intelligence, but rather on long, frequently complicated, and necessarily explicit, strings of logical thought.

Break one and they all break. Leave one out, and the entire string falls apart.

That is why computers and computer networks so easily go haywire; It is also why, when tested in real life situations, the *intelligence-is-like-acomputer-program metaphor* itself begins to shake and then: break apart.
