## On the difference between limit and control

**Control** imposes order *from without* by projecting the predetermined thought, conditioned by the past, of what should happen. The need to control invariably increases as the disorderly, unexpected, side-effects of past efforts accumulate, which results in ever-greater unnecessary difficulties or complicatedness; In contrast, **limit** allows order to emerge *from within* by determining only what at any given moment should not happen. Limit is therefore open to the future and tends strongly towards ever-greater simplicity.
